Weir Mesa operates out of a 60,000 sq. ft. manufacturing facility, and maintains state of the art machinery capable of meeting the precise specifications of the company's product line. Several CNC lathes, Trevisan machines, manual lathes, and CNC mills are utilized in addition to a robotic welder and two hydrostatic well service pump test stands.
